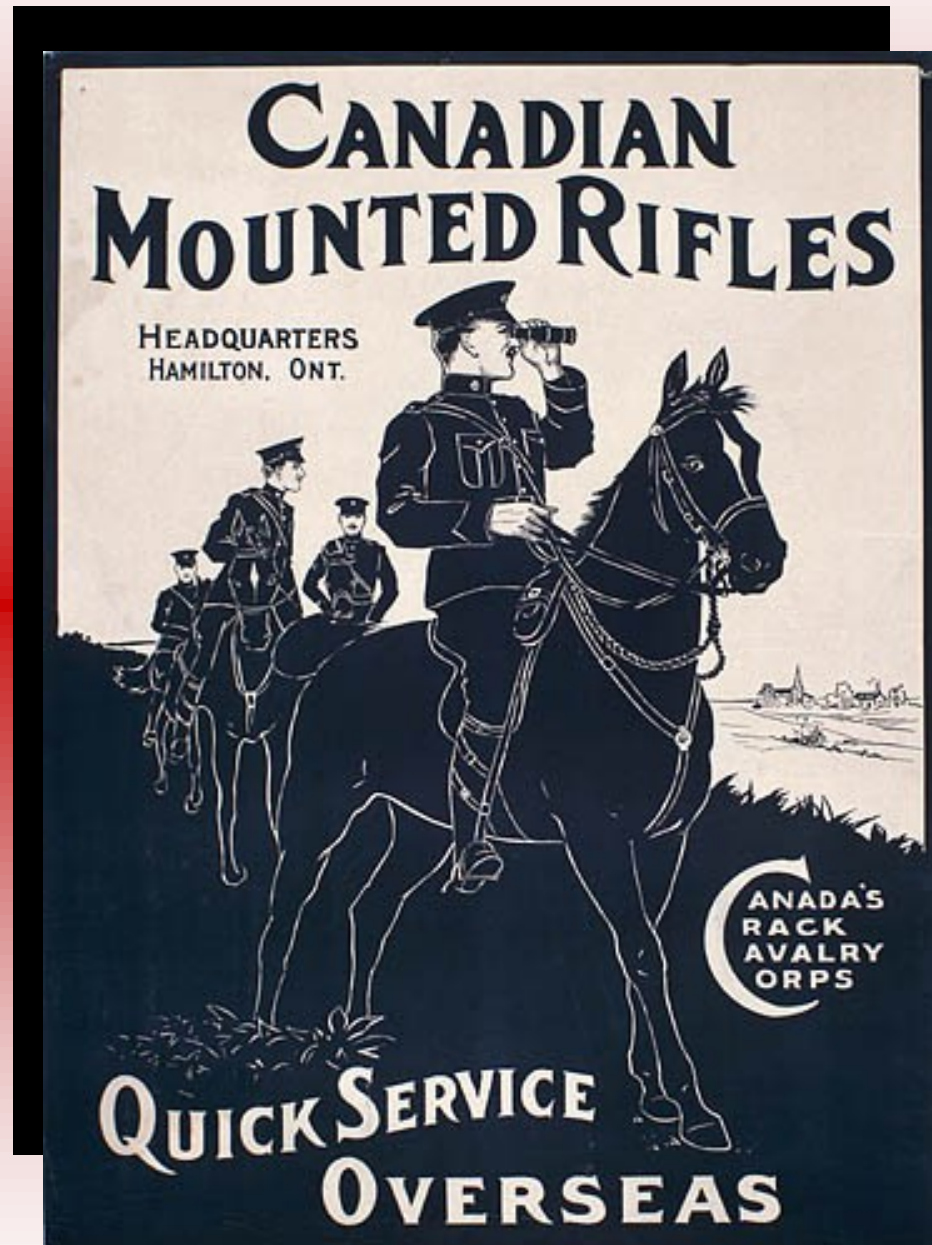


10th Regiment, Canadian Mounted Rifles

In January 1916, men from Lakehead were being recruited for enlistment with the 10th Regiment, Canadian Mounted Rifles.

Corporal Foster, of the 10th C. M. R., wintering in Portage la Prairie, who has been in the city for the past few days recruiting for that battalion, states that he has signed on fourteen young men from these two cities, and adds that not one of the fourteen would have enlisted with an infantry battalion. Three young men whom he approached on the subject were contemplating enlisting in the 94th, so in fairness to the local battalion, he would not induce them to join the 10th C. M. R. Corporal Foster will be in town for a few days longer and may be seen any evening at 837 Minnesota street. He desires to recruit seven more men before leaving. His battalion expects to leave for England during February.
