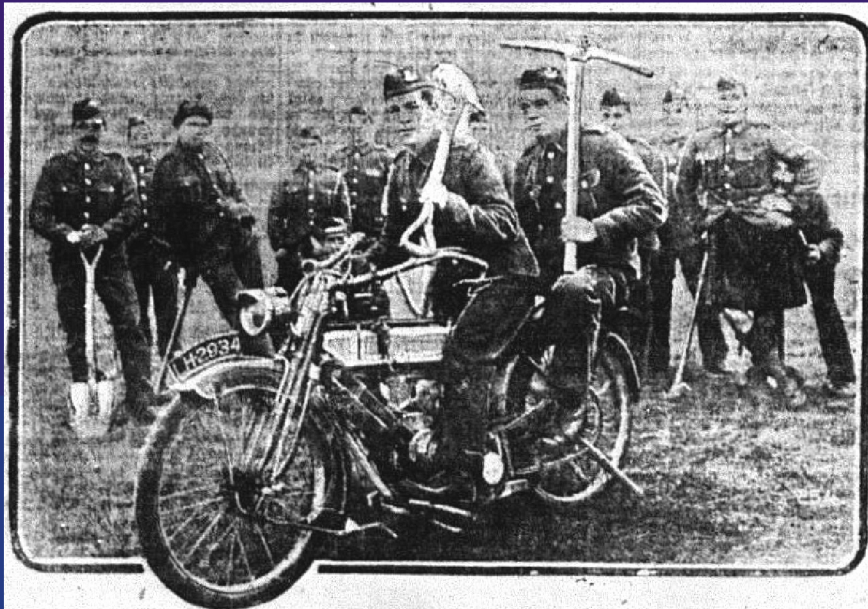


# OVER ONE THOUSAND MEN CONTRIBUTED TO EMPIRE BY HEAD OF LAKES CITIES

A RECORD THIS CITY MAY WELL BE PROUD OF



The February 26, 1915 edition of the Fort William Daily Times Journal published up to date statistics concerning the number of soldiers from the Lakehead contributing to the Canadian military war effort.

The fact that Fort William in conjunction with Port Arthur, has up to date supplied over 1,000 men for empire service is shown in the following figures:—

1st contingent (5 officers and 322 men)	327
Machine gun section (1 officer and 14 men)	15
2nd contingent (7 officers and 234 men)	241
Special contingent	127
Automobile section	20
On duty here	252
Volunteered for duty in future	100
