

28TH IN ENGLAND

A cable* received in Port Arthur late this afternoon by Mrs. J. M. McGovern, conveys the news that the Twenty-Eighth Battalion, composed of Port Arthur, Fort William and Winnipeg boys have arrived safely at Plymouth, England.

IN LATE MAY 1915, THE 28TH BATTALION, 2ND CANADIAN DIVISION, 6TH INFANTRY BRIGADE EMBARKED ABOARD THE SHIP NORTHLAND TO CROSS THE ATLANTIC. EARLY JUNE REPORTS CAME BACK THAT THE INFANTRY BATTALION, WHICH CONSISTED OF LARGE NUMBER OF FORT WILLIAM AND PORT ARTHUR SOLDIERS, ARRIVED IN ENGLAND.
