LONDON, May 8.—Eight officers remain of the 27 that into action with the Little Black Devils. Thirteen are in the hospital with wounds or gas poisoning, one is dead, Lieutenant J. E. Reynolds, four are missing, Captain G. Northwood, Lieutenant F. Andrews, Wallace MacKenzie and J. K. Bell. The officers wounded are Major J. Kilcaldy, Adjutant-Major Mothersill, medical officer, Major H. S. Matthews, Captains G. Watson, G. O'Grady, R. Burton, Durand, and Bustram. Lieutenants W. O. O'Grady, Harris Paget, T. Randall, G. Weld, Regimental Sergeant-Major W. Robertson. Severely wounded and missing are Company Sergeant-Majors Stewart and Mitchell missing, Company Sergeant-Major J. Hall.
