

Fort William Municipal Election

Harry Murphy
is re-elected
Mayor of Fort
William by
acclamation for
the 1918 term



At eleven o'clock this morning City Clerk McNaughton, acting as returning officer, declared Mayor Harry Murphy re-elected to the mayoralty for 1918, there being no other name submitted for nomination.

The mayor's nomination papers were signed by Geo. A. Graham, Alex Snelgrove and W. T. Rankin.

The attendance at the auditorium at the mayoralty nomination was very small, it being almost a foregone conclusion that Mayor Murphy would receive the third term by acclamation, this wish having been expressed by the city council at a recent meeting, and also by a strong delegation of ratepayers who waited on him last week.

The nominations for aldermen and board of education will take place this evening from 7.30 to 8.30.
