Pte. J. Armstrong, son of Postmaster and Mrs. W. A. Armstrong, arrived home last night with the other local men who came over on the Aquitania. His coming home was quite unexpected as telegrams which he had sent from Halifax and North Bay for some reason did not reach his parents. Pte. Armstrong left with the 94th battalion and was transferred overseas to the 28th, with whom he saw fighting from the battle of the Somme till the close of the war, from August of 1916 till October of 1918. He escaped without a wound, and had but two leaves of absence from the front
